2010 LAUTERBACH TALENT AND PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS

The College of Southern Idaho Department of Art will award several thousand dollars in scholarships to deserving individuals for the 2010-2011 academic school year. Each scholarship will pay for a portion of undergraduate resident tuition and fees for the fall and spring semesters. Recipients must be full-time students and must actively participate in the Art Department. Students looking for a challenging and rewarding art experience are encouraged to apply. **This application must be accompanied by the requested additional information.**

THOSE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY

New and continuing students will be considered. The granting of a Lauterbach Talent Award or a Presidential Scholarship Award does not mean a student is admitted to the college. All admission standards must be met before an award can be granted. In order to be considered for an award, applicants (new and continuing students) must deliver a portfolio (actual work, slides, and/or digital portfolios are acceptable) to the CSI Department of Art on or before the first Friday in March. In order to be eligible for a talent award, the student applicant must take a minimum of 12 credit hours. **Scholarship winners are required to enroll in the Art curriculum as outlined in the college catalog, otherwise the talent scholarship will be cancelled.**

PORTFOLIO

The portfolio is very important and considerable attention should be given to its composition. The portfolio should contain at least 10, but no more than 15 items of recent actual work, slides or digital images of work. Ceramic or sculpture pieces may be included. All flat work must be suitably matted or framed. Mark each work, slide, or digital image with your name and address, title, medium and year of completion. Include the scholarship application form with your portfolio. Portfolios may be picked up at the LaVar Steel Art Complex after the first Friday in April. If you wish to have your portfolio returned to you after the jury process, make sure to deliver your portfolio in a reusable container and provide clear shipping instructions.

INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITH YOUR PORTFOLIO

- * A short letter requesting consideration for an art talent award, including a statement about your education and career goals, potential as an art student and financial need.
- * Include two letters of recommendation from individuals who know your potential as an artist and/or student. **Not necessary for continuing CSI students.**
- * Official transcripts from high school and/or colleges you have attended. Current cumulative grade point average should be clearly defined. **Not necessary for continuing CSI students.**
- * A stamped self-addressed envelope or reusable container to return your materials.
